Operation Barcino: Tackling Vehicle Theft Overnight

Successful Drug Warrant Executed by PC Deacons

A Section 23 Misuse of Drugs Act warrant was executed at an address under the leadership of PC Deacons. The operation resulted in the discovery of over 30 cannabis plants, along with equipment linked to cultivation. One male was arrested at the scene and is currently under investigation. This action highlights our commitment to tackling illegal drug activity and keeping our community safe. Thank you for your continued support in reporting suspicious behaviour.
