Motor Vehicle Crime Advice

- Make sure the vehicle is locked.
- Invest in a steering wheel lock.
- Add a tracking device.
- Ask your car dealer if there have been any software updates to help secure it against keyless car theft.
- Use a signal blocking pouch (Faraday Bag) to keep your car keys safe. Include spare key.
- 6. Turn off keyless fob's wireless



What is a Safer Neighbourhoods Teams (SNT)

Your Safer Neighbourhoods Team (SNT) is a group of Met police officers dedicated to serving your community.

The team is made up of officers based in your area (or 'ward'), supported by additional officers from the wider area. We work closely with local authorities, community leaders and residents to decide our policing priorities for the area.

This helps us to find useful, long-term solutions to local problems, while maintaining our wider focus on reducing crime across London.

Bike marking event

The team organised a bike marking event at Riddlesdown Common car park. The aim of the event is to reduce cycle theft. Marking your bike or property is an effective way of discouraging thieves and enabling items to be returned to you should they be stolen. We have found it is an easy way for us to return the bike back to its owner.

The team were invited to attend a local nursery. We gave presentation on 'What do the Police do'. We brought along a Police response vehicle. The children also got a chance to try on some of our uniform. It was great to interact with some of the younger members of the community.




Burglary
