

Gas Network Upgrade – Sanderstead and Riddlesdown Area

We're preparing to carry out essential gas network upgrades in the Sanderstead and Riddlesdown area. This work will ensure a continued safe and reliable supply of gas is delivered to nearby homes and businesses. This is part of our 30-year programme of work to replace our old mains, reaching the end of their useful lives, with new, reliable plastic pipe.

Our contractor, WCB Utilities, who are completing this project on our behalf, will be starting work in the week beginning 16th September.

To ensure everyone's safety, we'll need to close the following roads around our work site while we have excavations open.

- Phase 1 Westfield Avenue from 16th September with an estimated end date of 15th
 November. These works will be carried out using a road closure from 26th September we will
 be working from the junction of Rectory Park to the junction of Copthorne Rise. The closure
 point will change as we move along the road. We'll also need to close the junction of
 Copthorne Rise to make the connections.
- Phase 2 Copthorne Rise This will be closed at the junction with Westfield Avenue from 14th October and we will work towards Hyde Drive. We will close the road at the junction with Hyde Road while we make the connections into this road and our closure will come down on Copthorne while we progress through Hyde Road.
- Phase 3 Hyde Road from 21st October with an estimated duration of 5 weeks, we will
 require a road closure to safely complete these works. Once completed we will return to
 Copthorne Rise to finish the last section on this road and the road closure will be lifted on
 Hyde Road but some works may remain.

Signed diversions will be in place for affected motorists where roads are closed. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses.



We're writing to residents and other local stakeholders to explain the details of this work. This letter can be shared with anyone you feel may have an interest in our work.

We understand roadworks can be frustrating. However, the new plastic pipe has a lifespan of 80 years. This means that once our work is done, Riddlesdown residents and businesses will be able to enjoy the benefits of a safe and reliable supply of gas for many years to come.
